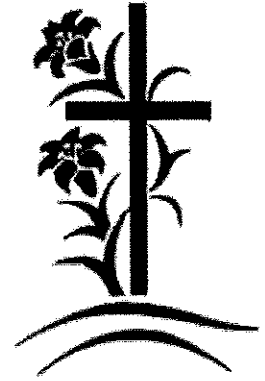
Find the path that takes Mary to the tomb.

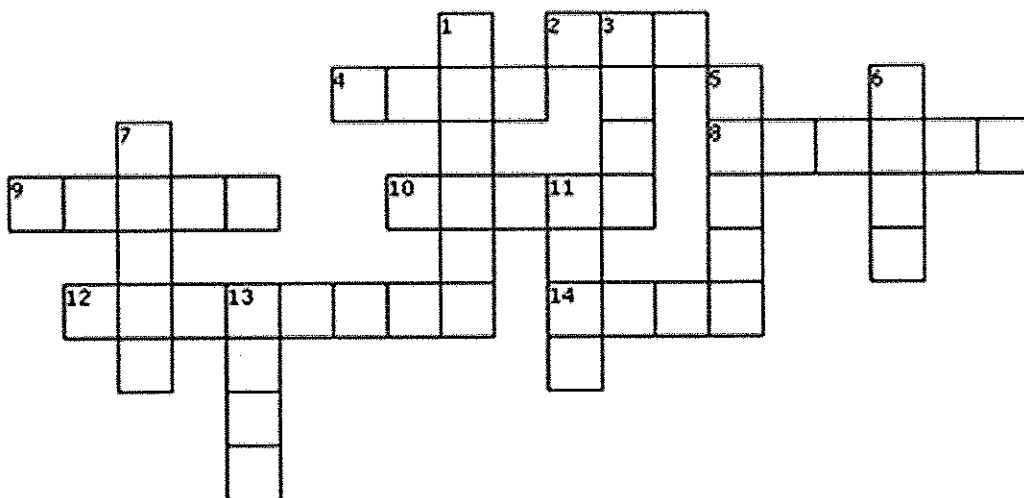
